A multidisciplinary team of clinicians whose aims are to improve the health and quality of life of people who are adversely affected by mental illness and substance use.

We utilise a variety of theoretical models that aim to reduce the harm often caused by alcohol and/or drug use.

We offer a range of strategies to minimise harm working along a continuum which could include abstinence.

We strongly support and work collaboratively to assist with the provision of an integrated treatment approach.

Clinical case support

Assessment and intervention for people with a co-existing severe and chronic predominantly Axis I mental illness and alcohol and/or other drug abuse or dependency.

We will:

- * Work with the clients inclusively, with their significant others where possible
- * Work in partnership with the clients Inpatient Mental Health Team or CMHC key worker and Psychiatrist.

This includes:

- * Comprehensive assessment and integrated treatment planning
- * A mobile team providing assertive outreach and longer term treatment.

Consultation

For clients of CMHC's and Inpatient Mental Health Services when there are concerns about the client's substance use.

This includes:

- * Client assessments
- * Dual Diagnosis treatment recommendations.

Liaison

This includes:

- * Information, education
- * Links and networking
- * Support (including group support)
- * Attending clinical meetings.

Training

- * Skills based Dual Diagnosis training programs for Mental Health professionals and support workers
- * Post training support and follow-up
