CADS Medically Managed Withdrawal Services

Supporting people at home, in the community or in an inpatient unit

CADS Medically Managed Withdrawal Services (MMWS) are for people who are physically dependent on alcohol and other drugs (e.g. benzodiazepines, methamphetamines, opiates) who require medical support to withdraw (detox) or to reduce their use or to stabilise on medications.

Physical dependence is when people:

- Need to increase how much they take to get the same effect
- Experience physical and psychological withdrawal symptoms if they stop drinking or using drugs

CADS provide medically managed withdrawal support through two services:

- CHDS/Community and Home Detox Service supporting people at home or in the community
- In-patient unit for people who need 24 hour medical oversight
