



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
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CADS Medical Detoxification Services are for people with a physical dependence on alcohol or other drugs (e.g. opiates, benzodiazepines, methamphetamine)

Physical dependence is when people:

- Need to increase how much they take to get the same effect
- Experience physical and psychological withdrawal symptoms when they stop drinking or using drugs

CADS have two detox services to support people to withdraw or reduce their use or stabilise on medications:

- The Community and Home Detox Service (CHDS) team can support you at home or in the community
- The in-patient unit is for people needing 24 hour medical supervision
